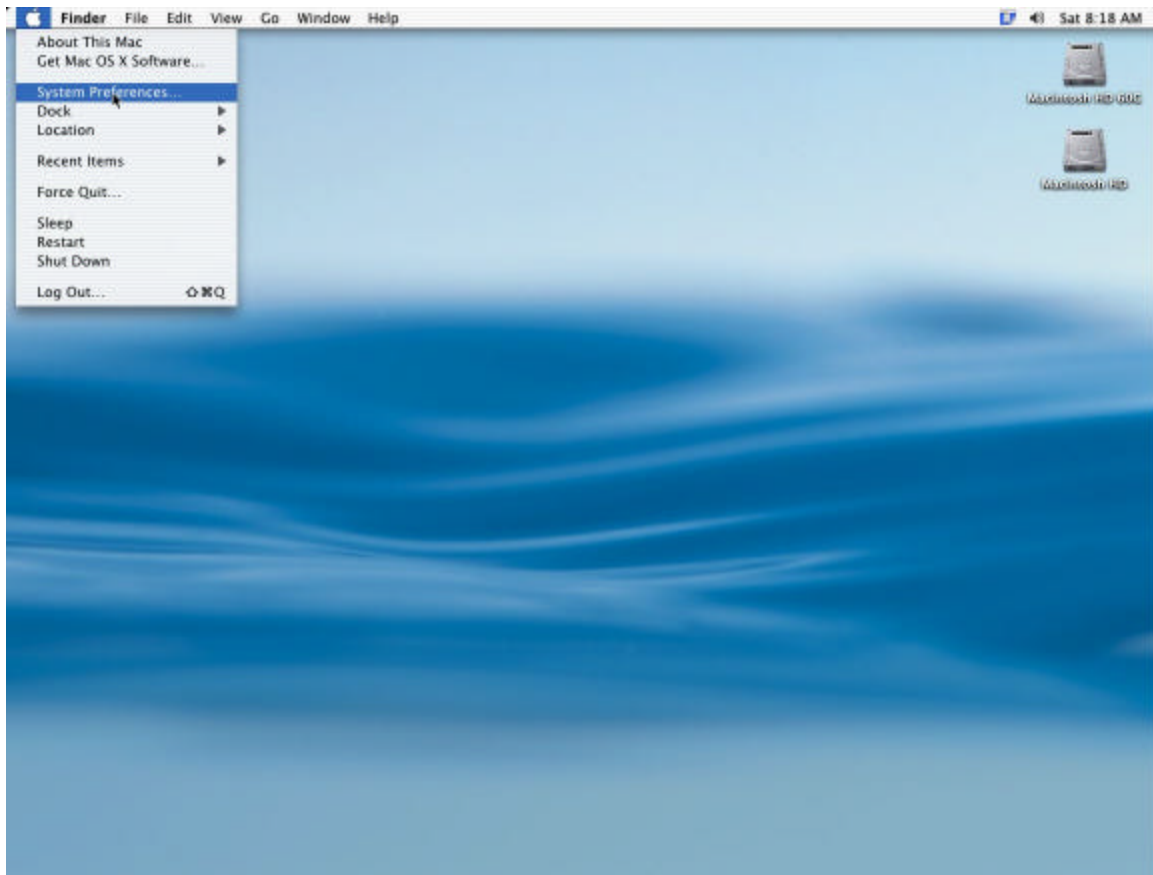
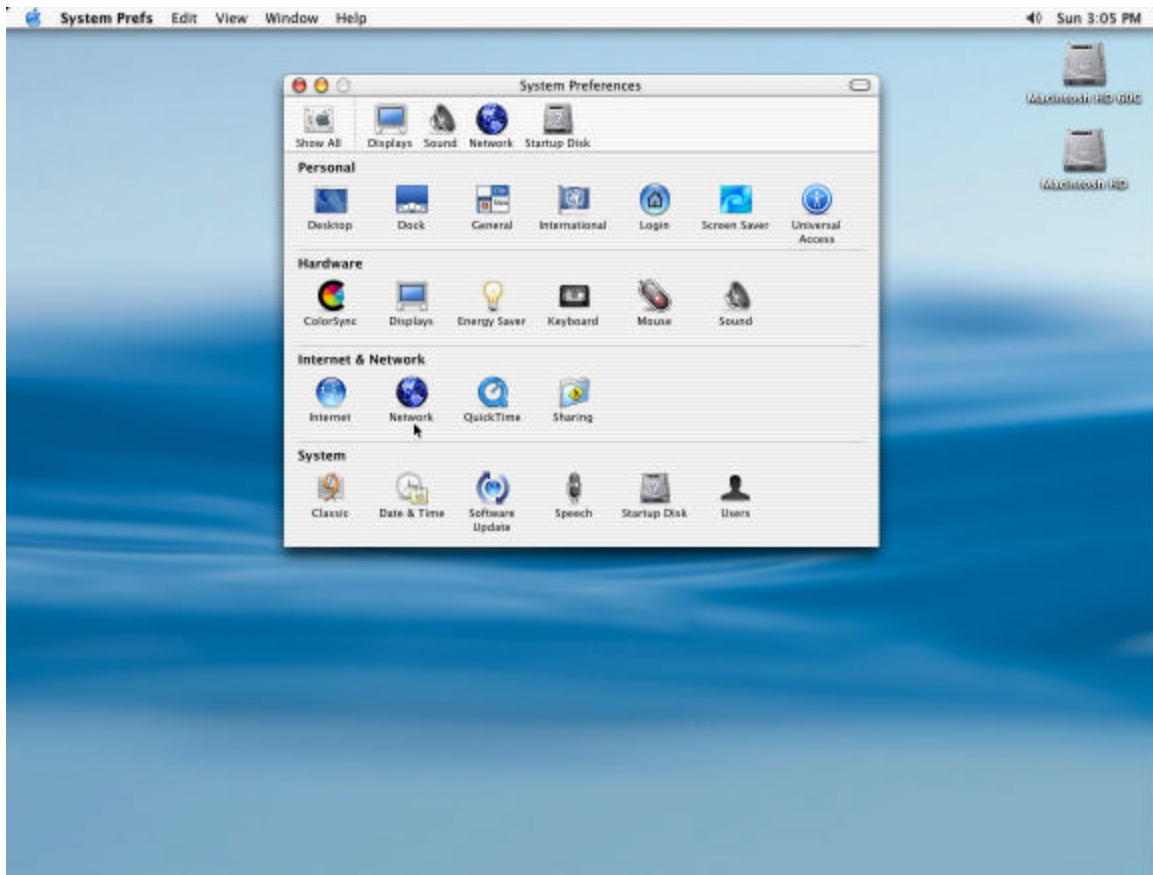


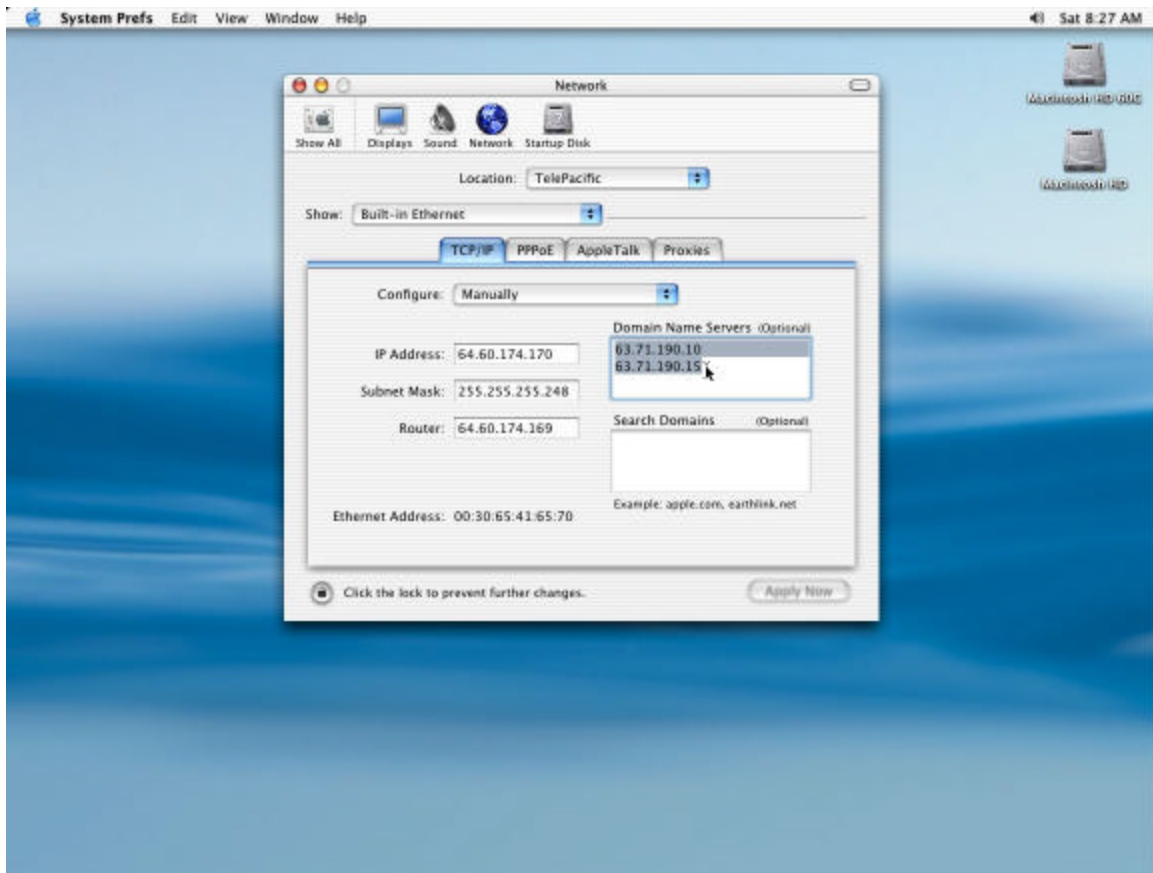
1. Click on the “Apple Menu” on the top left corner and select “System Preferences”.



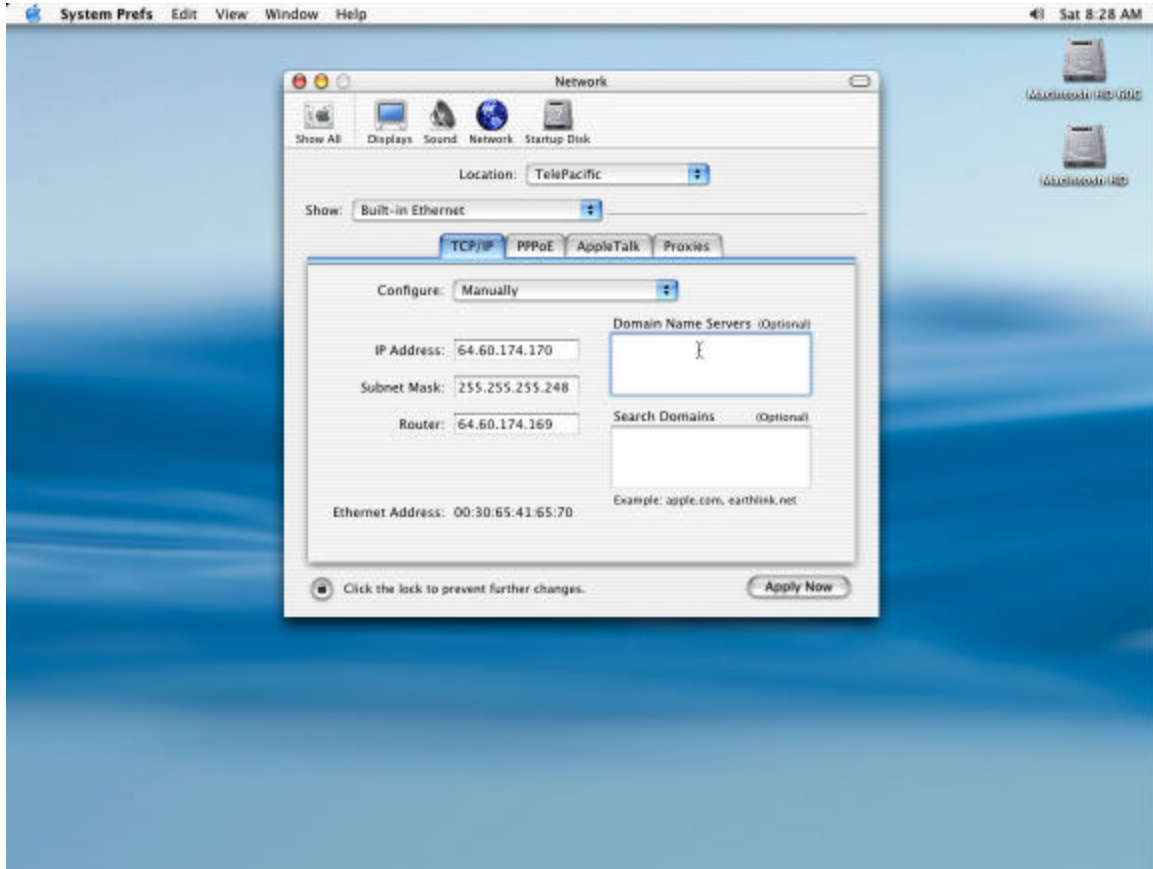
2. A “System Preferences” Window will pop-up. Double-click on “Network”.



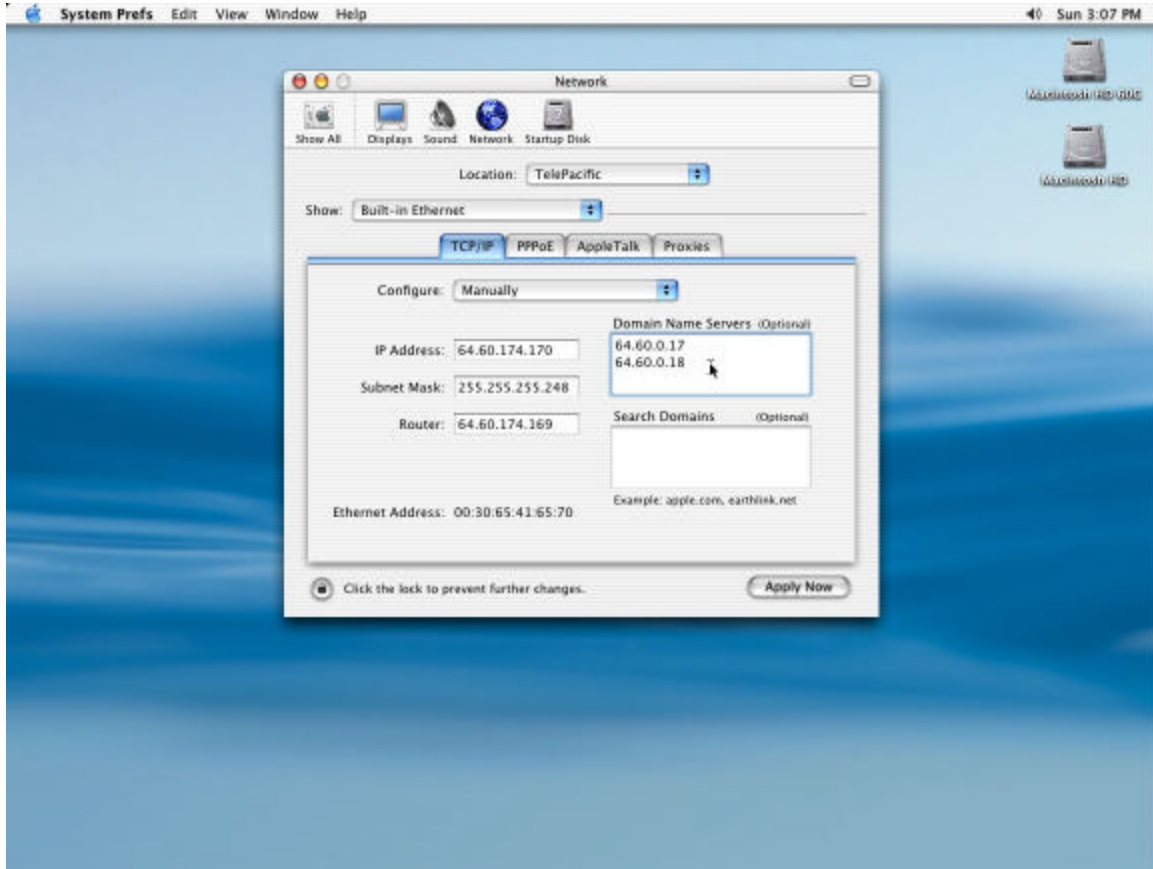
3. Highlight the IP Addresses in the “Domain Name Servers” Box.



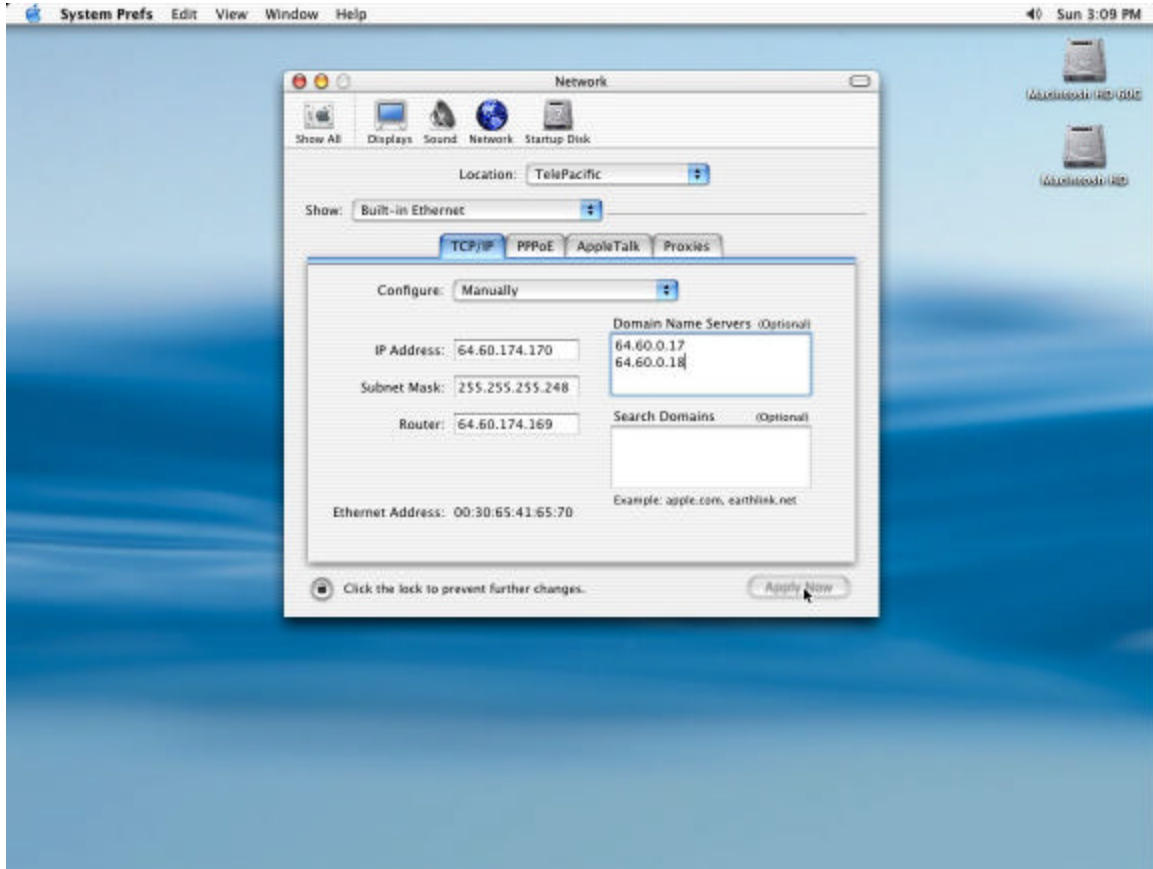
4. Delete the IP Addresses in the “Domain Name Servers” Box.
