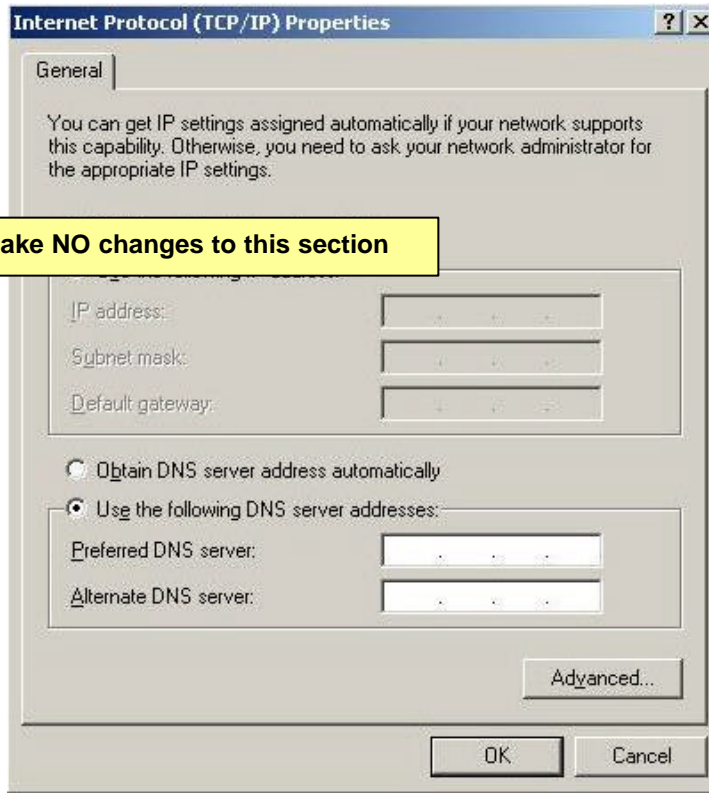

In the Internet Protocol Properties window, click on “Use the following DNS server addresses:” radio button if not done already. Type in the DNS IP address for your respective city.

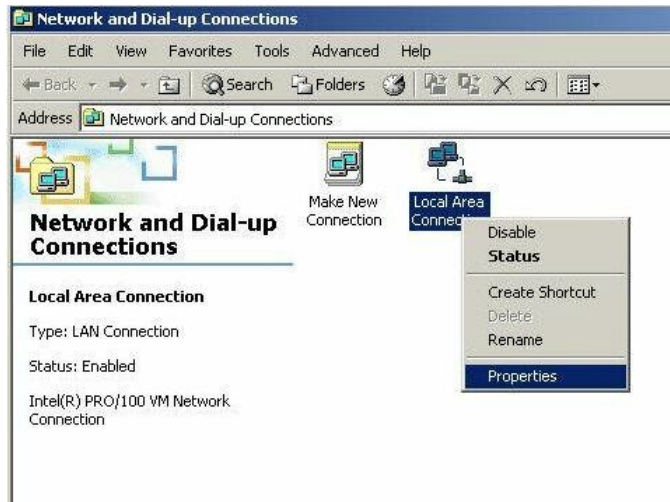
Click the “Ok” button, and then again for “Local Area Connection Properties”. Close the “Network and Dial-up Connections” pane and you’re all done.

Changing DNS on Windows 2000 Pro/Server

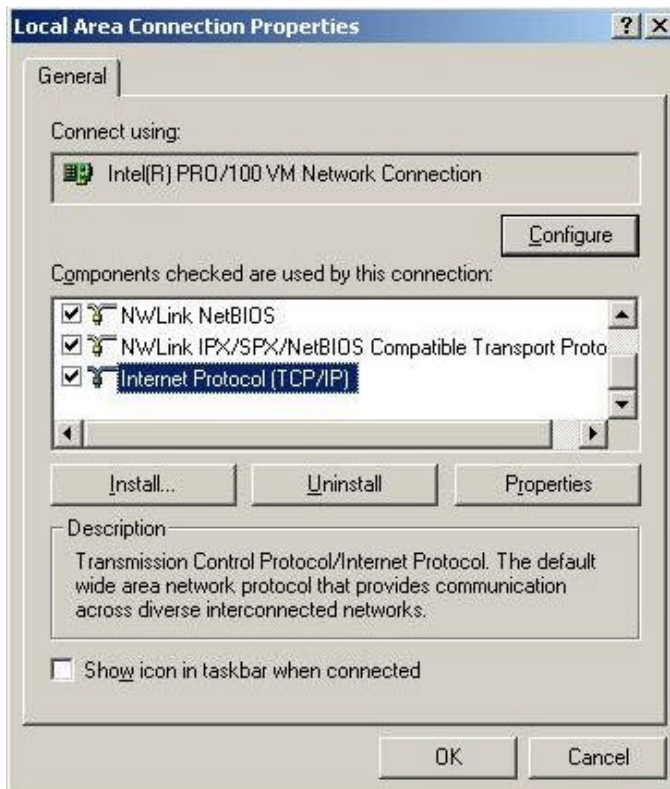
On your desktop, right click on the “My Network Places” icon, then left click on the Properties menu. Network and Dial-up Connection will pop up.
